RESOLUTION GRANTING SCOTT W. ANGELL A HARDSHIP EXCEPTION TO THE RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS FOR DEPARTMENT MANAGERS

WHEREAS on June 21, 2018, the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners authorized the County Manager to establish personnel policies for Forsyth County employees and to make such amendments as necessary to the Forsyth County Employment Handbook;

WHEREAS the Residency Requirements subsection of the Employment section, the Handbook states that no person is eligible to be appointed as a Department Manager, Deputy County Manager, Assistant County Manager, or any office or position which must be filled by the action of the Board of Commissioners unless the person is a resident of Forsyth County or becomes a resident no later than 180 days after the effective date of appointment;

WHEREAS the Residency Requirements subsection allows the Board of Commissioners to grant hardship exceptions to the residency requirements upon recommendation of the County Manager;

WHEREAS Scott W. Angell, a current Forsyth County General Services Department Director, has been employed by the County for 10 years, is thoroughly qualified as the General Services Department Director based on his knowledge and experience;

WHEREAS Scott W. Angell desires to reside in the adjacent Yadkin County to provide care for his family members who reside there, and it would be a hardship for him to remain in Forsyth County; and

WHEREAS the County Manager recommends that the Board of Commissioners grant Scott W. Angell a hardship exception to the Residency Requirements;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that upon recommendation of the County Manager, Scott W. Angell is hereby granted a Hardship Exception to the Residency Requirements effective March 21, 2021, pursuant to the provision of the Forsyth County Employee Handbook.
