**RESOLUTION FIXING THE FEES THAT MAY BE CHARGED BY
FORSYTH COUNTY DEPARTMENTS FOR NOTARY
ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS, VERIFICATIONS, OR PROOFS
WHICH ARE PERMITTED OR REQUIRED BY LAW**

WHEREAS, N.C.G.S. 153A-102 authorizes the Board of County Commissioners to fix the fees and commissions charged by county officers and employees for performing services or duties permitted or required by law; and

WHEREAS, N.C.G.S. 10B-31 and 10B-118, respectively, provide that the maximum fee that may be charged for notarial acts is \$5.00 for paper notarizations and \$10.00 for electronic notarizations; and

WHEREAS, it is requested that the fee for notarizations by County Departments be fixed at an amount consistent with the maximum fee allowed by law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners that notary fees that may be charged by Forsyth County Departments is hereby fixed at an amount consistent with the maximum fee allowed by law.
